For several years, SLCC has not been charging the trail fee along with cart storage. The trail fee is required for any private cart that operates on the course. Regardless of where your cart is stored (at your home or the course), members will need to purchase the yearly trail fee or pay a daily fee each time they use a cart on the course. While we understand that this has not been done for several years, it is a necessary fee that is in line with other local courses and will help us better maintain the course.

SLCC will participate in the Iowa Reciprocal, which allows members to golf at 38 other Iowa courses. A list of those courses will be included in your Membership Packet when you purchase your membership this year. Members just need to request the Iowa Reciprocal Membership card and rent a car at the participating course.
